GENERAL JOB DESCRIPTION

This seasonal position oversees the success of camp programming and management. Executes equipment pick-ups and drop-offs, supervise assistant coaches, and ensures quality of program activity delivery (camp activities Bible Battles, snacks, daily opening and closing programs, training and other camp needs). Works with Director of Camp Operations, Administrative Assistant and other RTW Staff to implement camp programs - skill building activities, games, Team Time lessons, etc. Support and take a leadership role in daily check-in and check-out at camps, parent communication, and staff supervision. Provides a quality experience to campers & families focused on RTW's vision of sharing the gospel through sports and developing winners on and off the playing field. Represents God, Run To Win and self in a professional manner of safety and fun. All employees are required to comply with the Run To Win Employee Handbook.

MAJOR DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

• Oversee camper and coach day-to-day procedures and activities

- Pick up and drop off camp equipment at RTW Office
- Responsible for set-up and clean-up of camp
- Responsible for creating and implementing an engaging camp agenda that improves campers' sports skills

• Responsible for organizing and leading Welcome, Bible Battle, Group Game, and Close-Out/Camper of the Day

• Teach sport specific skills, sportsmanship, and strong character throughout camp activities

• Responsible for Camper Check-In and Check-Out according to camp procedure • Arrive 45 minutes before the start of camp on the first day. Arrive 30 minutes early for the remainder of camp

- Lead or delegate prayer during pre-camp coaches huddle
- Report any injuries and/or incidents according to camp procedure
- Lead by example and adhere to Run To Win Coaches Code of Conduct and policies
- Communicate with Camp Director in timely and consistent manner
- Commit camper names to memory
- Maintain a FUN and encouraging attitude
